# "I am so excited to be joining Trinity on its journey to share the good news of Jesus Christ. I come."

Getting to know our new Rector, The Rev. Sarah Carper-Morris:

Sarah grew up on a farm near Christiansburg, Va. with mother and two brothers. She is a cradle Episcopalian growing up at St. Thomas in Christiansburg. She was active in high school sports, drama, and 4-H. Sarah earned her B.A. in Health and Physical Education from Berea College in Kentucky where she also played volleyball and basketball. She received her Master's Curriculum Development Instruction from The University of New Mexico.

She taught school in West Virginia, Virginia, and Germany before attending seminary at the University of the South in Sewanee, TN.

Sarah was a youth minister in Augusta, Georgia and Richmond, VA. She is a national trainer for the Journey to Adulthood Curriculum and she co-authored the Disciples of Christ 16/20 curriculum for senior high and young adults. During her time as a youth minister, she also led youth pilgrimages to Turkey and Greece; Germany, England and France; Spain; and Scotland.

Sarah was ordained in 2011 and has been serving at Christ Episcopal Church in Pearisburg, VA. While there she has led two youth pilgrimages to Santiago, Spain and Belize. Christ Church has also worked to serve the low-income community in Pearisburg. She also teaches and coaches at Eastern Montgomery High School, in Elliston, VA.

Sarah is married to Robert Morris who is Presbyterian Minister and is the director of a campus ministry house called The Shelter at Radford University. Sarah & Robert will be joining us for a time of fellowship at 3:00 pm on December 16<sup>th</sup>. Please make plans to join us for a reception and welcome them to our Trinity family.

From information in the Parish Register of Trinity Episcopal Parish:

From the Parish Record: "During early spring of 1896 a church lot was bought and paid for [and a] deed obtained. About May 1<sup>st</sup>, ground was broken for the church, and so faithfully was the work pushed forward, that in July, 1896, the first service was held in the newly completed building... At a called meeting of Trinity Church Mission, held Thursday evening, September 17, with Mr. Thomas Fawcett, Chairman, and Thomas Woodroffe, secretary to receive the report of the treasurer of the building committee," the following expenditures were reported.

Organ and freight	129.68
Lamps	11.50
Cornerstone	10.00
Building, pews, chancel furniture	
and carpet	1,296.00
TOTAL	\$1,747.18

(That would be \$49,305.49 in 2018 dollars)
